Consent for Photos

Under the recently implemented Data Protection legislation (GDPR), we were obliged to 're-ask' all of our parents for consent to use photographs in the newsletter and website.

Unfortunately, many of you have not yet returned consent forms, and many of you have decided, on being 're-asked', that you don't want your child's photos featured on the website and / or the newsletter.

Bearing in mind that, last year, ALL parents were happy for images to be used to positively promote the school and pupils' achievements, and to share individual successes and experiences of your child.

There are many that have been left out of this edition for that reason.


In addition, the consequences of mistakenly publishing one are potentially damaging.

Uniform Reminders

Please remember that uniform is an important part of our community and identity. It is vital that we retain this important part of school life.

This week, we have seen non-uniform items creeping in, and in particular, I need to draw your attention to:

- Hair colouring of ANY kind is not permitted; this includes hair braides and extensions
- Hair bands must be simple in style and in the school colours of green, yellow or white
- **Shoes** trainers are NOT permitted; plain **ALL** black trainer-style shoes are permitted no logos, flashes or soles
- Nail varnish and cosmetics are not permitted
