## When in Rome

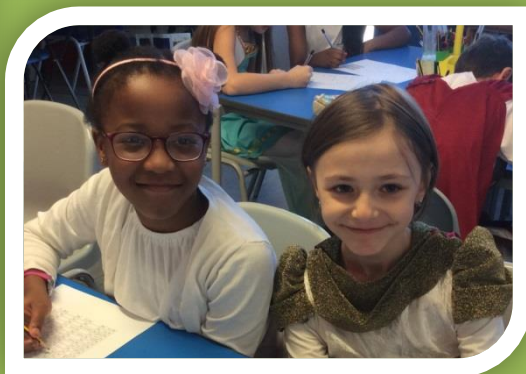
Year 4 'Do as the Romans do'

### Veni, vidi, vici

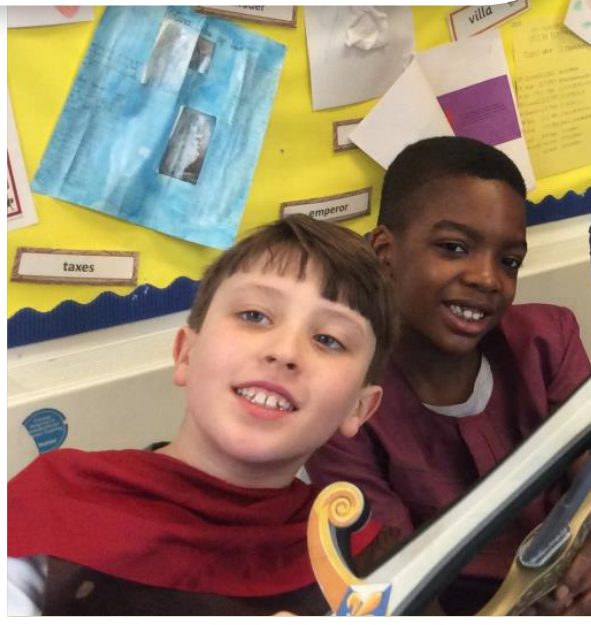

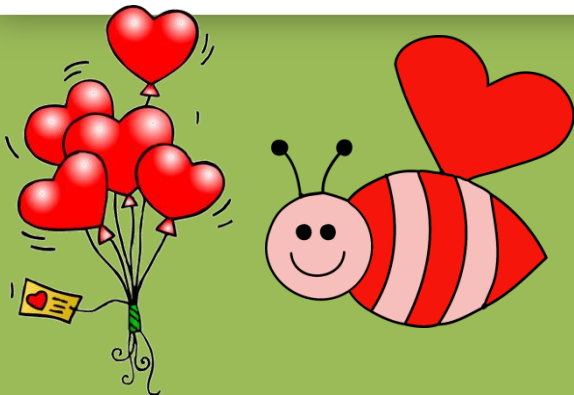




## Valentine's Cake Sale
