




## **Our Curriculum – Parent Guidance and Support**

# School Uniform Issues

May I remind parents that school uniform is compulsory and must be fully adhered to. Our uniform unites us, and it is both a source of pride and a sign of togetherness.

#### Shoes

Variations in footwear are most concerning: black shoes **ONLY** may be worn - **boots of any description are not permitted; logos and other colours are also not permitted.** 

#### Ties

Ties are compulsory in Key Stage 2, and must be worn with a white shirt.

#### Jumpers

These should be 'V' neck jumpers or cardigans. The green PE sweatshirts are for PE only and should not be worn as uniform.

#### Reminders

I will be asking teachers to send reminder slips home when they see nonuniform items being worn. Please can you ensure that the item is replaced as soon as possible.
