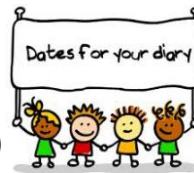


Here Comes the Sun!

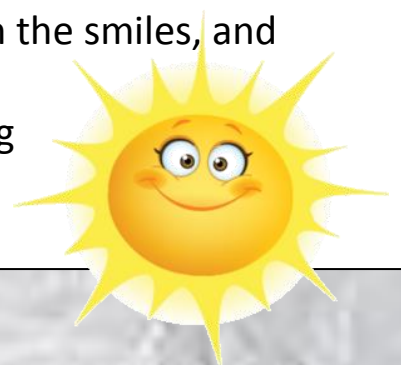
