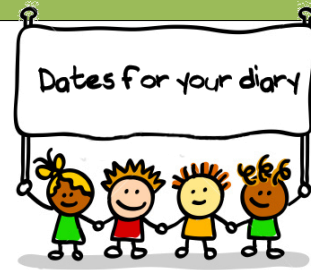

Brilliant end to Storytelling Half Term!

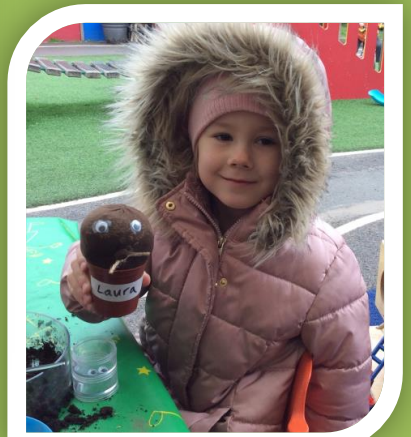
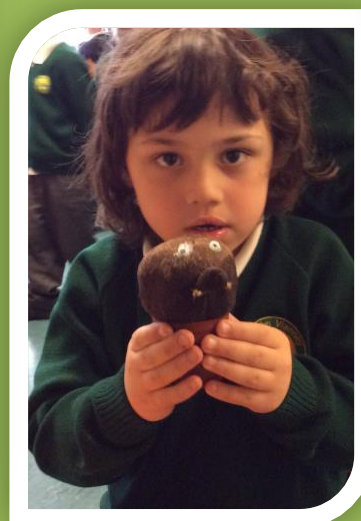

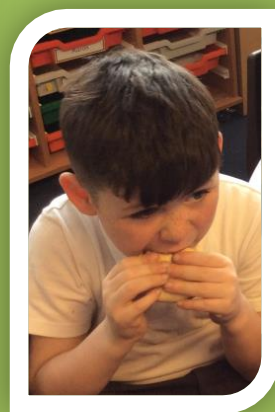




Grass Heads and Beanstalks!

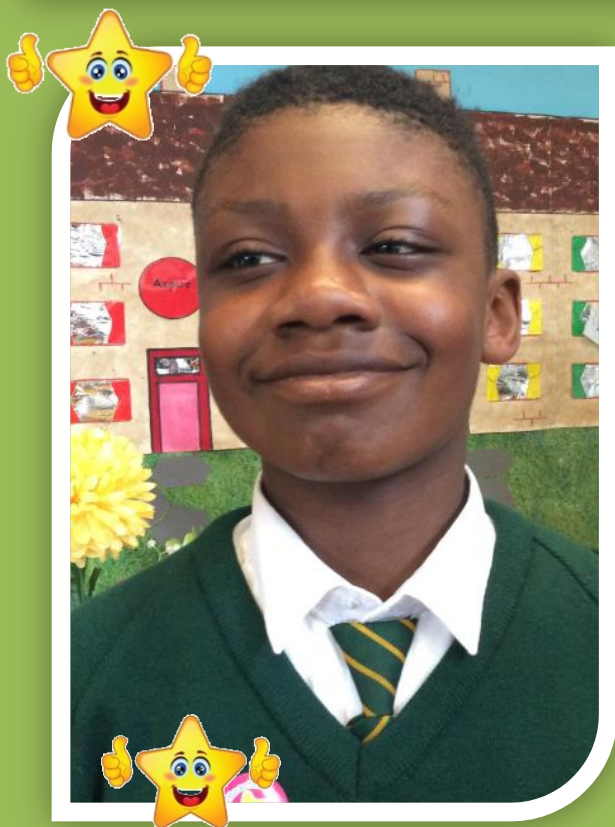
Man Cannot Live on Bread Alone

The aroma of fresh baked bread wafted through the school today as they started their healthy eating topic by whipping up some fresh bread – **scrumdiddlyumptious!**

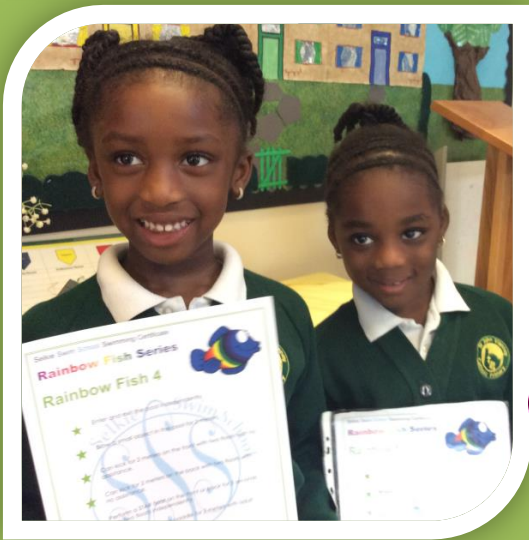
