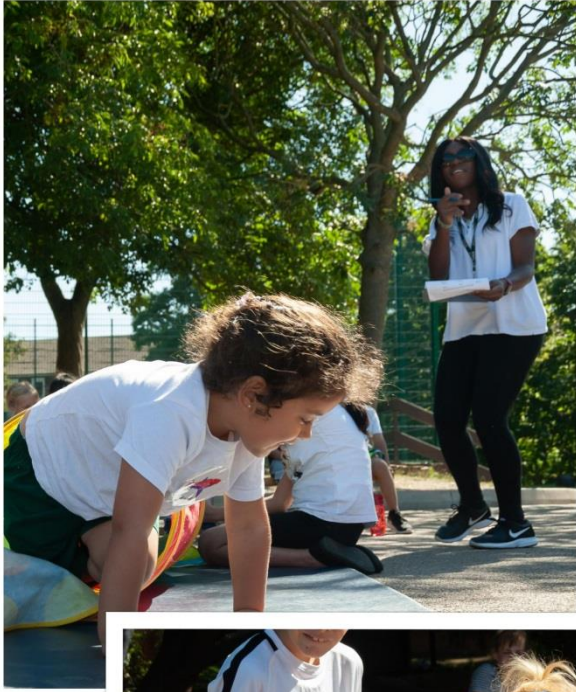


FUN IN THE SUN

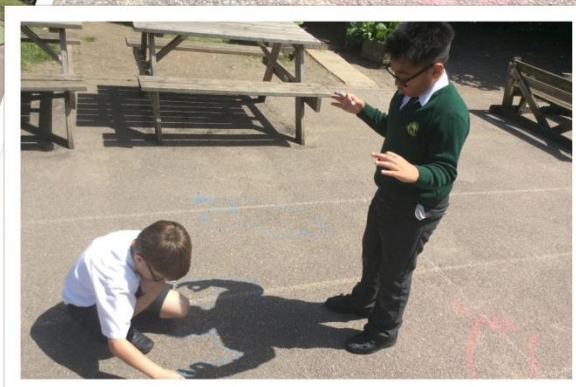

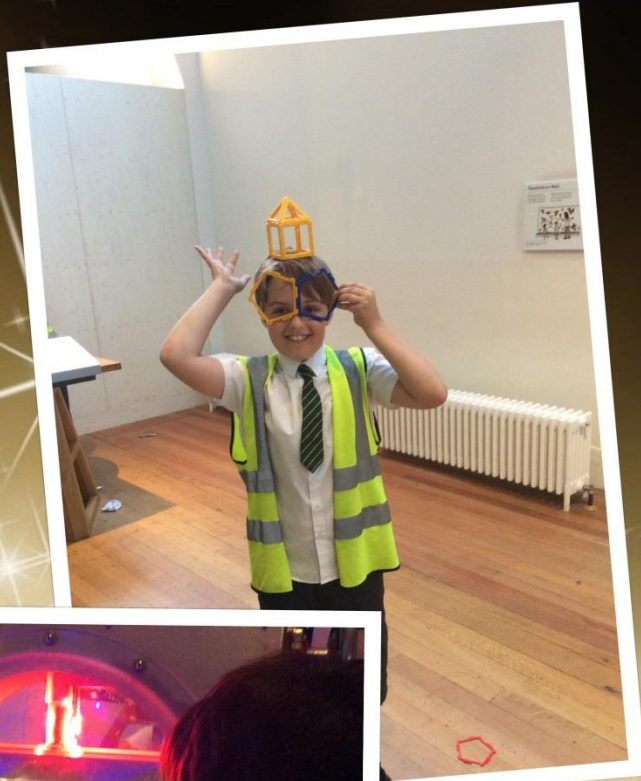

The Science of Shadows!

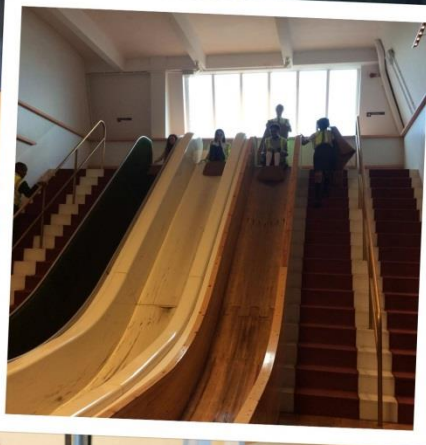
