





Down Where It's Wetter!


Under the Sea - it's 'better down where it's wetter', apparently!



Trainees leave the park and go on road with the instructors during the course.

All instructors are DBS checked. Bikeability Certificates and Badges are awarded to trainees who successfully complete the course.
